For 26 years we have been dedicated to placing a spotlight on issues that are often difficult to discuss as a community. We have been successful in highlighting the need for equity, unity and justice for all people and our precious Earth through performance and community activism. Each year we donate 10% of proceeds from our Spring Concert to a West Michigan organization fighting for social justice. A few of the local organization we have donated to over the past nine seasons include, Girls, Inc., Grandville Avenue Arts and Humanities, Justice for Our Neighbors, HQ, the Michigan Human Trafficking Task Force, and Girls Rock. We have performed at Temple Emmanuel's Holocaust Remembrance Service and took part in many community centered activities including volunteering at Gilda's Club, marching to support black lives after the horror in Charlottesville, and connecting with the Mental Health Foundation of West Michigan, and other mental health organizations, to bring attention to and provide resources to help reduce the incidences of suicide in our community.
