

GRWC Guidelines for Selecting Partner Organizations

- Organization's mission and values are well aligned/compliment the mission and vision of GRWC. Examples of this include:
 - Organization celebrates and honors the diversity of women's lives,
 promoting women's rights and equality for women
 - o Promotes social justice and peace within our community
 - Advocates for marginalized groups
 - Embraces diversity, equity, and inclusion of different races, ethnicities, sexual orientations, gender identities, religions, physical abilities, cultures, etc.
 - We consider embracing diversity, equity, and inclusion to mean that the
 organization does not restrict, screen, or limit its clientele or
 partnerships based on the above characteristics. The organization does
 not merely tolerate differences but celebrates them and actively seeks
 out ways to promote diversity, equity, and inclusion.
- In general, religious groups will not be considered for a GRWC partnership.
 Community organizations that receive support from any religious group(s),
 however, will be considered as long as they meet the above criteria.
- Volunteer opportunities within the organization are not required, but are preferred, especially if there is the ability for chorus members to volunteer as a group.
